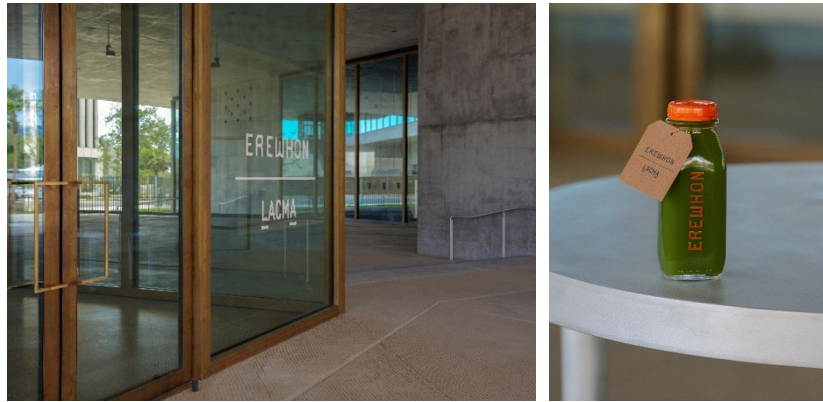


## LACMA Invites Los Angeles Icon Erewhon to Inaugurate New Café
